Both Brokk machine and drill is radio operated. The drill is mounted on a 360 degree rotator and together with Brokk's unique arm system almost any position is possible.



The Brokk/TEI drill has feeder of 5ft and can drill up to 20ft deep with a 2inch diameter drill.
